A school's sales tax exempt status is available only to the school itself. School organizations cannot use the school's sales tax exempt status. A school related organization, such as a P.T.A. or an Athletic Booster Club may qualify for sales tax exempt status on its own, and must have its own sales tax exemption identification number.
